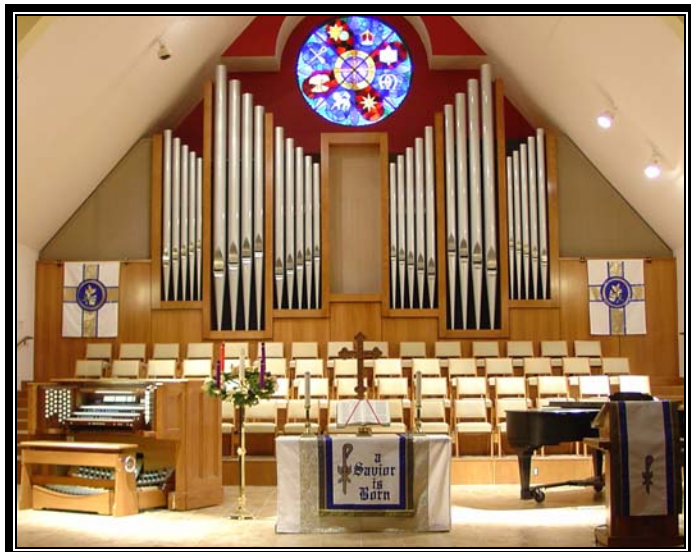

The nucleus for a new pipe organ for Saint John's United Methodist Church was Reuter Opus 1500, a two-manual instrument of 15 ranks built in 1965 for the Old Presbyterian Meeting House in Alexandria, Virginia. All parts of the original installation were comprehensively renovated for use in this greatly expanded tonal scheme. Designed to be completed in two phases, the three-manual console that is already installed will accommodate a Choir division that will be built in phase II. The following specification represents the completed instrument.
