Reuter Opus 1197 has faithfully served Centenary Methodist Church since its installation in 1957. The console was upgraded with a Matters solid state system in 1996. For its 50th anniversary, the organ's tonal resources were expanded to include six new ranks of pipes and a full length, 16' extension of the Swell Trompette. A new façade, created from freshly refurbished Great and Pedal principal pipes, was added to complement the arched chamber openings of this Civil War era sanctuary.
