Reuter Opus 1258 was originally built in 1958 for the University of Kansas and used as a studio organ in Murphy Hall. It was moved and installed at Barry Christian Church in 1986. In 2006, the Reuter Company updated the installation with a new solid state switching system and added an additional six ranks of pipes for an improved tonal scheme. The work was coordinated with simultaneous Sanctuary renovation that included a new hardwood chancel floor for improved sound reflection.
