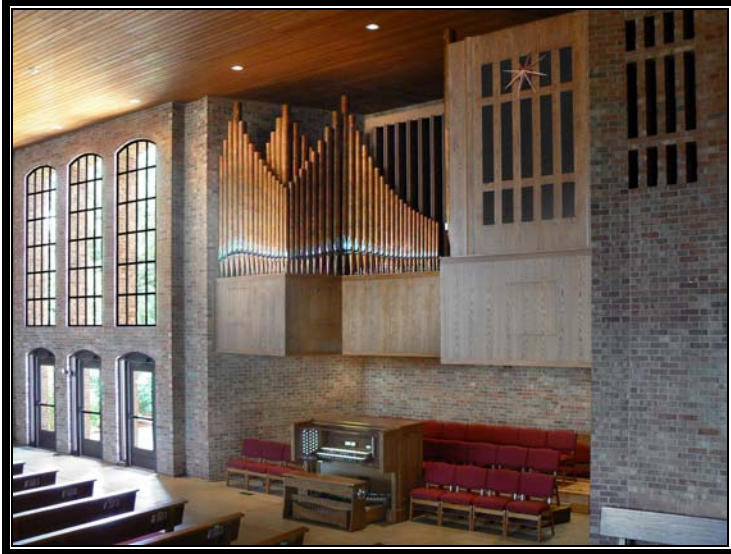


# FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

*Möller Opus 10,342 was built for First Presbyterian Church of Lawrence in 1968. After over 40 years of service, it was showing definite signs of age. This comprehensive rebuild essentially doubled the size of the instrument. It incorporated the best tonal resources from the original organ to form the basis of a substantial, versatile Swell division, paired with a Great division consisting of all new pipe work. Many chests, reservoirs and other mechanical components from the existing organ were refurbished and redeployed in the expanded specification. An all new solid state drawknob console completed the project.*
