Reuter Opus 1718 was originally built in 1970 for the First Church of Christ, Scientist in Bismarck, North Dakota. It was moved to Florida in 1998, where it was used in both church and residential settings. In 2011, new stop controls, pistons, wiring, solid state components, mechanical upgrades and tonal additions were completed in conjunction with its installation in Christ Church Parish. Space has been reserved for future additions.
