*Reuter Opus 2232 was completed in 2010 for University Presbyterian Church. It incorporates components from an earlier Reuter instrument built in 1977 for Second Presbyterian Church in Freeport, Illinois. The vintage pipework was rescaled, revoiced and redeployed to become an integral part of the well-developed tonal resources of this two-manual instrument. A new drawknob console was designed to match other cherry furnishings in the award-winning, renovated sanctuary. Space has been reserved for future additions.*
