Reuter Opus 1641 was originally built in 1968 for Westminster Presbyterian Church in Fort Smith, Arkansas. This organ was subject to significant design changes for its new church home. It was completely cleaned and new winding materials were installed. All chests were rewired and a solid state operating system was added. The new façade was created using refurbished Pedal pipes. Finally, the console from Reuter Opus 1922 was renovated to replace the original console and complete the project.
