Reuter Opus 1008 was built in 1952 for Richardson Auditorium at Southwestern College in Winfield, Kansas. A project to update the organ in 2011, after almost 60 years of service, was scheduled in conjunction with the Great Performances Capital Campaign and the renovation of the auditorium. The organ was removed and stored at the Reuter facility while the hall was completely refurbished. Work on the organ included installation of solid state components, cleaning and regulating pipework, and a new console. Additionally, the chest layout was reconfigured for the north chamber, providing improved access for tuning and maintenance. Finally, twin facades were designed from existing pipework to replace the grills that formerly covered the chamber openings on either side of the stage. A dedication concert was presented as a part of Founder's Day celebrations in 2012.
