Reuter Opus 1259 was built for Bay Minette's First United Methodist Church in 1959. This six-rank unit organ served the church well until 2005, when Hurricane Ivan tore the roof off the building. Remarkably, the old organ was completely restorable and has become the swell division of Opus 2228, designed for their new church sanctuary. The instrument now features five additional ranks of pipes and a stopkey console that will provide for future additions. The completed installation will eventually include a total of 17 stops and 20 ranks.
