

Reuter Opus 1736



Original installation



Currently at Reuter

- As built in 1970, the instrument will fit under a ceiling of 10'-6".
Pipework could be mitered to accommodate a lower ceiling.
- The foot print for this organ, excluding manual and pedal keys, is 8'-10" wide by 5'-8½" deep. The pedal clavier projects 2'-10" beyond the front of organ case.
- The blower and rectifier are self-contained inside the case and operate on 110-volt AC. There is no combination action, but a crescendo pedal is included.
- The organ case is made of oak. For residential use, a Quinte or a second flute could be substituted for the Mixture.
